Use of resource:

Fluid Thirst Cards- enlarged pictures of information on fluid handout to use in interactive discussion with dietitian

Purpose of resource:

To facilitate interactive discussion & activities to help dialysis patients control the amount of fluid they have and avoid heart problems.

Content

• Different options for controlling thirst.

Key skills (Competencies):

A patient should be able to:

- Tell you what happens if they have too much fluid.
- Tell you how they know they are having the right amount of fluid.
- Tell you how much weight they can put on between dialysis days.
- Tell you what too much fluid can do to their heart.
- Show you how many cups of fluid they can have each day.

Key Health Messages

- If you do dialysis drink small.
- Try ways to stop you feeling thirsty.
- Try to gain no more than 2 kg between dialysis days
- If you have problems talk to your dietitian, nurse or doctor.
